THE APPEAL - V4 And they said this to him every day. When he did not listen to them, they told Haman about it. They wanted to see if Haman would accept Mordecai's behaviour because Mordecai had told them he was Jewish.



THE ANGER - V5 When Haman saw that Mordecai would not bow down to him or honour him, he became very angry.



THE AMBITION - V6 He thought of himself as too important to try to kill only Mordecai. He had been told who the people of Mordecai were, so he looked for a way to destroy all of Mordecai's people, the Jews, in all of Xerxes' kingdom.


