When Haman saw that Mordecai would not bow down to him or honour him, he became very angry.



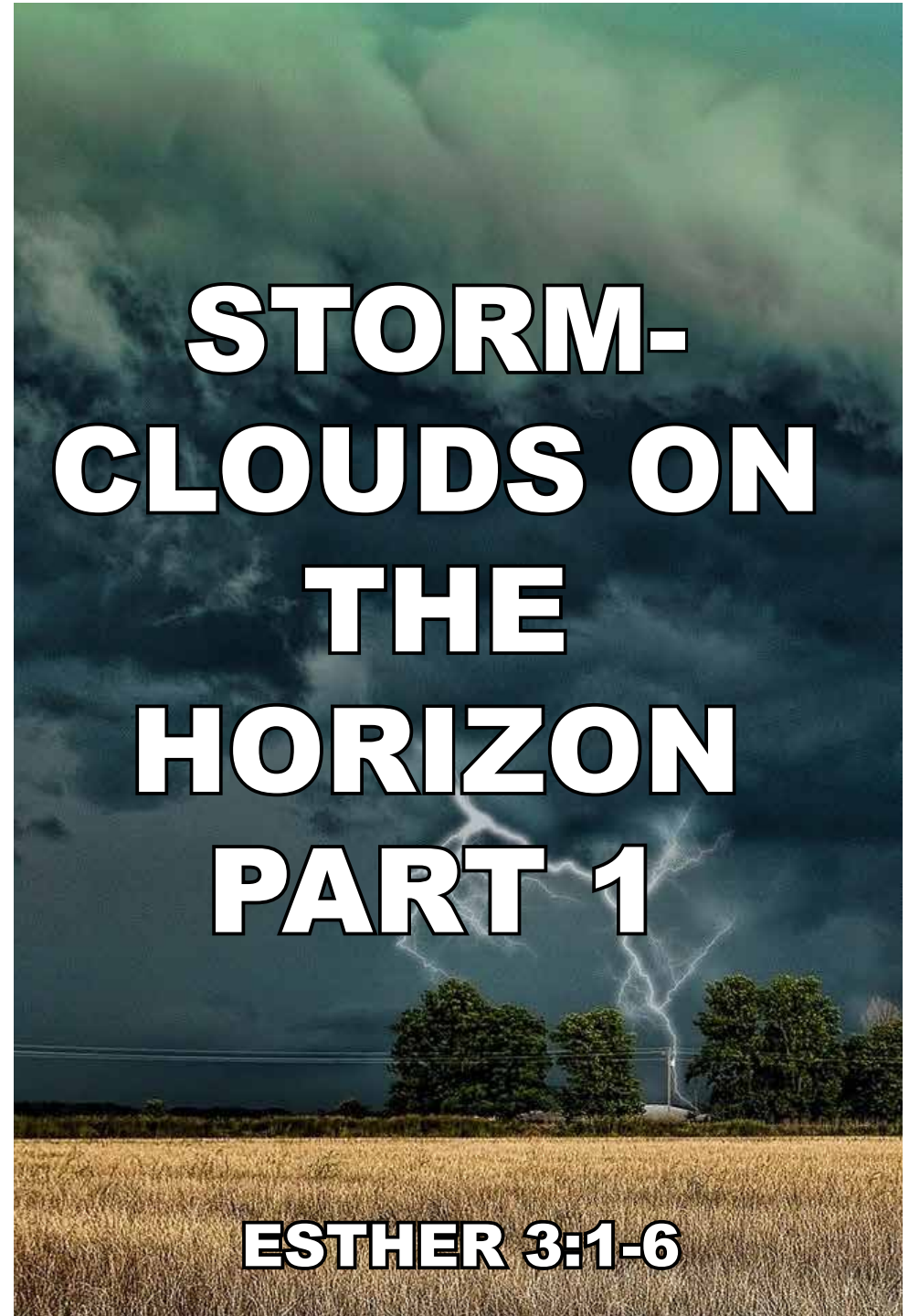
THE AMBITION - V6
